5:10 - Financial report

- 106K in federal credit union
- 1st Tennessee 80K
- Fine on cash flow
- Profit and Loss
 - Paychecks for Sept, Oct, Nov, and December (Dec has been run but not dist
 - Other expenses are heavy at the start
 - Our bookkeeper is contracted (as is preferred by county), she works one day a week
 - Checks are written by her, unless required when she is not here.
 - Two check signers per check
 - o Eichhorn, Slater, Markum and Jenny are signers
 - Food expenses:
 - Not budgeted for as they are expected to pay for themselves
 - However it takes time for the county/state to reimburse so currently in the red for those.
 - Budget plan for 2017
 - Left column was approved in June
 - Right column is adjustments that
 - Arrows show what adjustments mean
 - Per pupil funding increased to 7800.00 per student
 - Capital outlay went up
 - Title 2 funds went up
 - But has to be used exclusively for teacher development
 - Special Education Grants went up
 - Response to instruction and intervention
 - Went into effect this year
 - At tier 2 level teacher to student ratio must be 1:5
 - Budget buster
 - Added at Teacher and Ed Assistant Category
 - Also effects increases in taxes, fica, and medicare and benefits
 - Insurance costs were a huge situation



- Needs to be discussed
- Building Development (Rainy Day fund)
- Janitorial Services
 - Current resigned
 - New service is much higher (commercial)
- Advertising reduced to 8K
 - May be able to come up with other campaigns to assist
 - Teal feels like it will be fine for now.
 - Times Free Press submitted could be a \$2000 benefit
- Debt Service is longer than we thought.
- Still in the black, but barely.
- Question regarding RTI2
 - Any chance of additional funding since this was an unfunded state mandate?
 - No.
 - Fran spends time in the classrooms and feels it is helping, students are getting good instruction
 - o How many Level 2 are there?
 - Approx 45 out of 200
 - We have 25% of special ed students, the highest in the county.
- Question on minutes from last week
 - Building funds: can this new found funds be used for architecture services
 - Perhaps: will need to be decided by committee
 - Cantus is talking to people who might be able to offer pro bono work on the new building
 - Fran has a brother in the painters union who may want to
- We need a personnel committee and a building committee
- Received an alarming message from another charter school, that we were on a list for closure.
 - Angie reached out to county and asked for a meeting to discuss and make sure we are all on the same page.
 - Meeting was set, but due to the Woodmore tragedy it was postponed to Dec 13th.
 - We must be in flagrant violation of charter they can close us.
 - We were granted a charter until school year 2023-2024.
 - Both Dr Kelly and Zach Brown have been invited to visit multiple times and have not visited.
 - It is possible they have received testing scores we have not seen. The flawed tests cannot be used to evaluate teachers or students, but can be used to evaluate the school.
 - To be clear, the rules are not fair. County schools have different rules than charter schools.
 - Our 25% special ed students is not taken into consideration in the scores.
 - We need to be patient and wait and see what was actually said.

- Bob would be happy to draft a letter to the paper to bring it to public attention.
- Fran is now working for the school and can no longer be on the board.
- Fran offered her resignation.

Committees

- Building: Sally offered to Chair
 - o Fran volunteered to be on the Building Committee
 - Don volunteered to be on Building Committee
- Personnel: Mitch nominated to Chair
- PR/Events: Teal Thibauld and Ginny Kelly will Chair
 - Judy volunteered to be on this committee
- Finance committee: Don will head up finance until we have a final stance on Dillon. Status on Dillon is hold til he is back in February. He will help while he is here in December.
- Responsibility of Chair is to recruit other members and hold a meeting
 - Bob brought it up that he has attended several board trainings, and the #1 reasons charter schools fail is finance. Academic failure is also tied to finance.
 - Cantus: Wants to create greeting cards with student art and photography. Put 10% of proceeds go to the student for use at Ivy or for a college fund.
 - Grant for Memorial will be handled by Linda and Allison. Applying for this specifically for Running with Sasquatch.
 - Linda also brought up that she is beyond time to roll off board. But could stay with committee
 - Grant funding on P&L is typically
- Community Grant funds are usually under \$5k
 - Community Foundation
 - o Unum

 - Kelly Subaru

- Need special project list for ones that fall outside of school. (compiled by Angie, Ainsley, Holly, etc) and then we as a board can assist in putting them together. (with copies of former grant applications).
- Bob suggested a staff member also be on each committee, as it would be very helpful.
- Teal suggests when we ask for donations for events/programs to OVER ask and then
 use overages for other areas.
- Bob suggests we move from emergency fire fighting on issues to being proactive and work on future projects.
- Let's have committees have a conference call or email thread and have someone report on it at the Jan meeting.
- Cumberland Trail Festival is at Ivy on the same day as Running with Sasquatch. Will
 make is a great combined event.
